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Fresh Fruit and Vegetable Sampling Methods

1 Scope

This document specifies the basic requirements for sampling fresh fruits and vegetables, the sampling process, sampling methods, packaging, labeling, storage and transportation of laboratory samples, etc.

This document applies to the sampling of fresh unprocessed fruits and vegetables.

2 Normative references

3 Terms and definitions

The following terms and definitions apply to this document.

3.1 Batch products lot

Collected together, with a certain quantity and consistent characteristics/features (same variety or type, maturity, specifications and packaging are basically the same, etc.) product.

3.2 Packed product packed product

Fresh fruits and vegetables that are packaged in certain quantities using packaging containers and materials and traded directly.

3.3 Unpacked product

Fresh fruits and vegetables that are packaged and traded directly in certain quantities without using packaging containers and materials.

3.4 Sample increment

Samples taken from various sampling points in a batch of product.

3.5 Mixed sample bulk sample

A sample obtained by mixing or evenly combining multiple random samples taken from a batch of products.

3.6 Reduced sample

A sample representative of the bulk product obtained by reducing the composite sample.

3.7 Laboratory sample laboratorysample

A sample obtained from a composite sample or a reduced sample and sent to a laboratory for testing.

4 Basic Requirements

4.1 Sampling of fresh fruits and vegetables should follow the principles of authenticity, representativeness and economy.
