1 Scope

This guiding technical document specifies the basic requirements for citrus production, including the selection and management of the base, the management of inputs, the management of production technique, the integrated control of pests, labour protection and record keeping. This guiding technical document applies to the growing and production of Satsuma mandarin.

This guidance document defines the basic requirements for citrus production, including base selection and management, input management, production technology management, Integrated pest management, labor protection, archival records and so on. This guideline is applicable to the planting of Satsuma mandarin.

3.1 Base selection

3.1.1 Climatic conditions. The annual average temperature is 16 °C ~ 22 °C, the absolute minimum temperature is ≥ -7 °C, the average temperature in January is ≥ 4 °C, the year ≥ 10 °C Accumulated temperature above 5000 °C.

3.1.2 soil conditions. The soil texture is good, loose and fertile, organic matter content should be more than 1.5%, deep soil, living soil should be 60cm Above groundwater level below 1m.

3.1.3 Irrigation water quality. Requires no pollution of irrigation water.

3.1.4 Other environmental conditions should be consistent with the requirements of GB/T 18407.2.

3.1.5 To build necessary facilities such as roads, drainage and irrigation, water storage and ancillary buildings, Turtle Orangery should create shelterbelts. Shelter forest selection fast growing tree There is no symbiotic pests and diseases with citrus. Flat and slopes below 6 ° gentle slope, planted north-south behavior. Should use rectangular planted plant. Gradient in the 6 ° ~ 20 ° mountain, hilly land, planted row line and ladder to the same direction. Should use contour planting. Ladder level to the direction Should have 3 per mille ~ 5 per mille of the drop.

3.1.6 Contiguous production area should be more than 3hm².

3.1.7 Fill in the "Basic Record Table of Production Base" (see Table A.1) and the "Record Table of Survival of Existing Biological Species in Production Base" (see Table A.2).

3.2 Base management

3.2.1 studio Base should have a studio for production office. Indoor tables and chairs, information cupboards and other facilities; placed on the production management record sheet; Zhang Paste the production of technical specifications, pest control safety standards list, base management, input management and other relevant rules and regulations.

3.2.2 base warehouse Base should have a dedicated warehouse, separate storage of pesticides, fertilizers and pesticides and other items. Warehouse should be consistent with safety, hygiene, ventilation, dark And other requirements, equipped with shelves, equipped with the necessary measurement of pesticides, protective clothing, first aid kit.
