This guideline is applicable to the production of sweet pea.

3.1 Production base selection

3.1.1 The environmental conditions of the production base shall comply with the requirements of GB/T 18407.1 and fill out the "Basic Record Form of Production Base" (see Table A.1) and "Record of Surveys on Existing Species of Biological Species at Production Sites" (see Table A.2). The selection of water sources for planting sites is convenient, the groundwater level is low, and irrigation and drainage are carried out Good, deep soil, loose soil, the first two years to three years without planting legumes of loam or loam.

3.1.2 The production base should be far away from sources of pollution.

3.1.3 contiguous area should be more than 3hm².

3.2 Production base management

3.2.1 studio Production base should have a studio. Indoor equipped with tables and chairs, information cupboard, etc., placed on the production management record list, posted production technology regulations Van, pest control safety medication standards list, base management, input management and other relevant rules and regulations.

3.2.2 base warehouse Production base should have a dedicated warehouse, separate storage of seeds, pesticides, fertilizers and pesticides and other facilities. Warehouse should be safe, sanitary, ventilation, avoidance Light, equipped with shelves, equipped with the necessary pesticide measuring tools, protective clothing, first aid kit, etc., and fill in the "production base of major agricultural equipment (tools) registration Table "(see Table A.3).

3.2.3 bathroom The base should have a washroom and maintain the cleanliness of the washroom.

3.2.4 Waste and pollutant collection facilities Production base should be set up respectively to collect waste, garbage and pesticide empty packaging and other waste and pollutants facilities.

3.2.5 Irrigation system

3.2.5.1 The production base should establish a separate management system of irrigation and drainage, such as reservoirs, water supply channels and irrigation equipment maintenance.

3.2.5.2 well irrigation wellhead should be higher than the ground 30cm above, and is equipped with protective equipment to prevent rainwater intrusion and abandonment of pollutants.

3.2.6 Plant Inspectors

3.2.6.1 Production base should be equipped with plant protection personnel, responsible for the prevention and control of pests and diseases, pesticide use management and records. Plant protection equipment should be equipped with the number Meet the needs of each base production, and fill out the "basic record of production base" (see Table A.1) and "production base registration form" (see Table A.4).
