This guiding technical document specifies the basic requirements for the production of baby pak choi, covering mainly the selection and management of the production base, the management of inputs, cultivation management, pest control, labour protection, batch management and record keeping. This guiding technical document applies to the growing and production of baby pak choi.

This Guidance Document specifies the basic requirements for the production of Kojima vegetables, including the selection and management of production bases, the management of inputs, Cultivation and management, pest control, labor protection, batch management, archival records and so on. This instructional document is suitable for the production of Asclepias.

3.1 Production base selection

3.1.1 Production base environmental conditions should be consistent with the requirements of GB/T 18407.1. Should stay away from sources of pollution. Contiguous area should be more than 3hm².

3.1.2 Fill in the "basic record of production base" (see Table A.1) and "record of the existing biological species production base record" (see Table A.2).

3.2 facilities cultivation Facilities cultivation can be plastic shed, small shed, solar greenhouse and shade net cultivation in summer.

3.3 Base Management

3.3.1 studio Base should have a studio. Indoor equipped with tables and chairs, information cupboard, etc., placed on the production management record list, posted production specifications, there Pest control safety medication standards list, base management, input management and other relevant rules and regulations.

3.3.2 base warehouse Base should have a dedicated warehouse, separate storage of seeds, pesticides, fertilizers and pesticides and other facilities. Warehouse should be safe, hygienic, ventilated, dark, inside Set shelf, equipped with the necessary measurement of pesticides, protective clothing, first aid kit, etc., and fill in the "production base of major agricultural equipment (tools) registration form" (See table A.3).

3.3.3 bathroom The base should have a washroom and maintain the cleanliness of the washroom.

3.3.4 Waste and pollutant collection facilities The production base should be set up respectively to collect waste and pollutants such as excrement, garbage and pesticide empty packaging.

3.3.5 Irrigation system The production base should be built irrigation systems, such as

storage tanks, rainwater harvesting, water supply pipelines, irrigation equipment maintenance, drainage and irrigation should be drains. Conditional , Irrigation facilities such as drip irrigation or sprinkler irrigation can be established.

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
