2 Project conditions

2.1 Evaluation of regional cultural characteristics Poverty alleviation organizations or implementation entities analyze local culture, geographic location, etc., and select and carry out processing based on regional characteristics project.

2.2 Evaluation of the ability of poor households

2.2.1 Assist the implementation subject to carry out capacity evaluation on poor households and implement classified guidance.

2.2.2 Poverty alleviation organizations, implementation entities or third-party organizations provide skills training for poor households so that they have the necessary knowledge of processing materials And skills.

2.3 Information Release Poverty alleviation organizations assist in the establishment of information processing platforms or display platforms for processing materials, release industrial development plans, processing agents, Work capacity and other information.

3 division of responsibilities

3.1.1 Provide basic information

3.1.1.1 Poverty alleviation organizations in the areas of processing with supplied materials

should provide poverty reduction plans for local processing with supplied materials.

3.1.1.2 Poverty alleviation organizations provide basic information on poor households, and assist the implementation body to accurately connect poor households.

3.1.2 Organization Promotion

3.1.2.1 Assist the implementation entities in propagating and promoting the poverty alleviation model of processing projects with imported materials, and issue support policies.

3.1.2.2 In the future, materials processing services are included in local entrepreneurial poverty alleviation projects to support poor households in processing materials.

3.1.2.3 Assist in integrating the resources of local processing social service organization, support the establishment of processing brokers (organizations), processing brokers People association.

3.1.2.4 In the future, materials processing services will be incorporated into local new vocational and technical training to assist in the organization of processing agents (organizations) and poor households Training.
