1 Scope

GB/Z 40885-2021 is the Chinese national standard on prosthetist service specifications, in the field of health care technology. The /Z suffix marks it as a guiding technical document: it does not prescribe requirements that can be certified against, but sets out the technique,

the method or the state of the art that the standards bodies recommend following. It was issued on 26 November 2021 by the State Administration for Market Regulation; Standardization Administration of China. As a guiding technical document it carries no separate date of entry into force: it applies from publication. Classification: ICS 11.040.40, CCS C45. This page is published from the official record of the standard held by the Chinese standards administration: the identification, the dates, the classification and the issuing body are taken from there. The clause text, the tables and the numeric limits are in the document itself, which is delivered complete in English translation.

3 Terms and definitions

3.1 Prosthetist Use relevant principles and methods of medicine, human biomechanics, and rehabilitation engineering to examine and evaluate people with missing limbs and issue false Professional technicians who prescribe, assemble, train, inspect, guide or supervise all procedures of prosthesis configuration, and perform compensatory function evaluation.

3.2 Assembly The work process of a prosthetist assembling special parts for prostheses and directly serving the people with missing limbs.

4 Service object

Those who are missing limbs (patients) who need prostheses.

5 Service purpose

By configuring prostheses for those who are missing limbs (patients), the limbs or functions that are compensated or partially compensated can be achieved, so that they can return to
