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Foreword

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Public resource transaction refers to the resource transaction activities of public ownership and public welfare that involve public interests and public safety. The country has adopted the law Bidding of engineering construction projects that must be tendered, assignment of state-owned land use rights and mining rights, transactions of state-owned property rights, government procurement, etc. Common resource trading platform. In order to improve the evaluation of the credit status of public resource transaction entities, and through the evaluation results, Implementing credit risk management and control is not only of great

significance to all parties in the transaction, but also of reference value to government supervision departments. To protect the legal rights of transaction subjects To ensure the fairness, openness, safety and legality of public resource transactions, improve the efficiency and sustainability of public resource transactions, and build an honest and trustworthy market In view of the market environment, it is necessary to establish a standardized implementation guideline for credit evaluation of public resource transactions. Based on the basic common indicators proposed in GB/T 23794-2015, this document refers to GB/T 23793-2017, combined with public Based on the credit characteristics of resource transaction entities, a credit evaluation index system for public resource transaction entities has been established; at the same time, refer to GB/T 22116- 2008, GB/T 31953-2015 and GB/T 22119-2017, give the grade representation and evaluation of the credit evaluation of public resource transaction entities Procedures and evaluation reports, etc., aim to provide standardized technical guidance for the credit evaluation of public resource transaction entities. 1 Scope

GB/Z 41465-2022 is the Chinese national standard on implementation guidelines for credit evaluation of public resource trading entities, in the field of services and company organization. 3 Terms and Definitions

GB/T 22116, GB/T 22117, GB/T 23793 and GB/T 23794 as well as the following terms and definitions apply to this document.

3.1 credit evaluation credit evaluation Integrity evaluation It is the activity of recording, analyzing and evaluating the integrity status of the subject under evaluation in a certain period, and marking its integrity status with a specific symbol.

Note. It refers to the comprehensive analysis and evaluation of the willingness, ability and behavior of various market participants to perform the contract by professional institutions according to specific methods and procedures. Estimates, and use standardized symbols to indicate the activities of their credit ratings. The scope of performance includes the provisions of laws, regulations and mandatory standards, contract terms and other contractual clarifications.
